### Setting up a standing order

### Gift aiding your donation



By Gift Aiding your donation you increase the value of it to us by 25% at no cost to you. The parish is able to reclaim the tax that you have already paid. The pledge form also includes a Gift Aid Declaration. In order for us to claim Gift Aid you must be a UK taxpayer.

### Using Tap 'n Pay for one-off donations after mass



We now have Tap'n' Pay machines which allow donations to be made via contactless payments. You can donate £5, £10 or £20. We thank Rochelle and Vanessa who are helping after Sunday masses with the card machine. It certainly has been a great help for many of you who wish to contribute to our parish.

### Offering masses and prayer requests

For any mass intentions or prayer requests of any kind (e.g., birthdays, wedding anniversaries, death anniversaries...), envelopes are available in the foyer next to the notice board. ### Using employer matched charity donation scheme

Some employers provide a matched charity donation scheme for their employees, where money is deducted from the employees' salary (before tax) and an equal amount is donated by the employer to the nominated charity. Please enquire with your employer if they operate such a scheme and whether it applies to regular payments or one-off donations only. You may also wish to ask Fr. Azad for assistance.
